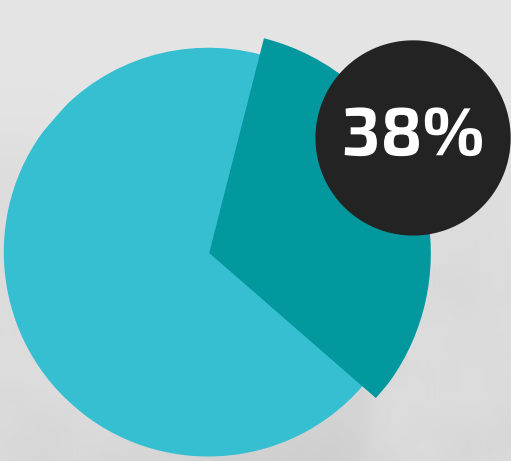


# ATTITUDES TOWARDS ONLINE LEARNING IN VIETNAM
